




Map showing CWS boundary



A	The area is entered by a small gap in the hedge along the road nearest the farm. A path leads down, close to the boundary, to near the bottom corner.
	To the N, the boundary is gappy hawthorn (<i>Crataegus monogyna</i>) and blackthorn (<i>Prunus spinosa</i>) scrub. The grassland has hairy tare (<i>Vicia hirsuta</i>), dovesfoot cranesbill (<i>Geranium molle</i>), common vetch (<i>Vicia sativa</i>), common catsear (<i>Hypochaeris radicata</i>), germander speedwell (<i>Veronica chamaedrys</i>), ribwort plantain (<i>Plantago lanceolata</i>), heath bedstraw (<i>Galium saxatile</i>) and scattered gorse (<i>Ulex europaeus</i>).
	Later in the season there is abundant bracken (Pteridium aquilinum).
	To the SW is an area of open acid grassland with patches of heather (<i>Calluna vulgaris</i>), sheep's sorrel (<i>Rumex acetosella</i>), occasional red fescue (<i>Festuca rubra</i>), soft brome (<i>Bromus hordeaceus</i>) and cocksfoot (<i>Dactylis glomerata</i>). Bracken is dominant in places.
	An old sand pit in the far SW corner has dense bracken also rowan (Sorbus aucuparia), ash (Fraxinus excelsior) and dog rose (Rosa canina). The field boundary is a gappy hawthorn hedge with scattered oak (Quercus robur), birch (Betula pendula) and gorse. There are mature oaks present.
В	Entering from about halfway along the NE boundary along the road, there is a very old oak (marked on historic maps). There is dominant bracken with scattered gorse and oaks of a similar age (c 100years). The ground is very undulating.


